Fabled Folded Dimensional Flowers

Adeline Johnson is going to come and teach us how to make the fabled folded dimensional flowers that she had made for a quilt that she showed at our "Show and Tell" last year.

Requirements: about 1 meter of tracing paper. Adeline likes to use the Reynolds white freezer paper, however any brand will do as long as it is white.
Steam-a-Seam
Back grounds: 16 ½" squares in mostly light colours (number depends on how many blocks you wish to make
Flowers: 4" to 8" pieces of fabric, any colour you wish, preferably no solids, 100% cottons fold nicely. Batiks are hard to work with, and Adeline does not recommend using them.
Stems: long strips of fabric, colours as you would want stems to be

Sewing Supplies: Your basic sewing supplies. (List attached)

Hand stitching is required for the flowers. Bring needle and threads in colours to match the fabrics you chose for your flowers.

Please note that Sewing Saturdays are open to everyone. You can take the workshop or work on your own projects.
